
- What is Different about Jewish Genealogy?

Locating Gravestones in Kansas City

GONE BUT NOT FORGOTTEN

A HISTORY OF THE BURIALS IN THE JEWISH CEMETERIES OF KANSAS CITY, MISSOURI



For most of us who have lost loved ones, it is a natural instinct, especially when we are grieving, to want to know where they are buried. Invariably, we often take this fact for granted, knowing that there is a place where our loved one provides comfort and we can visit periodically. As a rabbi, I have often had guests ask me about the location of an individual's place of burial, especially during the passage of time. When asked, I usually respond by saying that I do not know. This is because, while I have records that tell us a great deal about these buried individuals, even more importantly, the people who are buried in them. This is not to say that I do not know all of us—whether family or professionals—or as members of the faith. Being able to track and identify records, to determine the locations of sites and maintain personal as well as community histories, not only can comfort people and benefit our community.
